
The feedback received was overwhelmingly positive, with students appreciating the depth of knowledge shared by Dr. Babu and the practical insights gained from the

Report on Effective Communication Skills for Pharmacists

On 10-02-2021, Narayana Pharmacy College hosted an insightful session on "Effective Communication Skills for Pharmacists," led by K. Revathi. Revathi noted that non-verbal communication can significantly impact how messages are received and understood. Positive non-verbal signals can help build trust and rapport with patients.

- 5. Interprofessional Communication: Effective communication with other healthcare professionals is also vital. Revathi stressed the importance of clear and concise communication when collaborating with doctors, nurses, and other members of the healthcare team. Proper documentation and the use of standardized communication protocols can enhance teamwork and patient care.

The workshop concluded with interactive exercises and role-playing scenarios, allowing participants to practice and refine their communication skills. Feedback from these activities helped attendees recognize areas for improvement and build confidence in their abilities.

Overall, the session was highly beneficial, equipping pharmacists with practical tools and techniques to enhance their communication skills. As highlighted by K. Revathi, improving these skills not only enhances patient satisfaction but also contributes to better health outcomes and a more effective healthcare delivery system.
