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## **REPORT**

### **Industrial Visit to Maithili Life Sciences Private Limited**

On December 18, 2022, a group of 50 B.Pharm IV year students had the opportunity to visit Maithili Life Sciences Private Limited in Renigunta. This one-day industrial visit was organized to provide the students with a practical insight into the bulk manufacturing processes involved in pharmaceutical formulation development.

### **Introduction**

Industrial visits are a crucial part of the curriculum for pharmacy students, as they bridge the gap between theoretical knowledge and practical application. Such visits offer firsthand experience of the functioning of pharmaceutical industries and enhance the students' understanding of various processes involved in drug manufacturing. Maithili Life Sciences Private Limited, renowned for its advanced manufacturing facilities and adherence to stringent quality standards, provided an ideal learning environment for the students.

### **Arrival and Orientation**

The students, accompanied by their faculty members, arrived at Maithili Life Sciences early in the morning. They were warmly welcomed by the company's staff and given an overview of the day's schedule. The visit began with an introductory session where the company's history, mission, and core values were discussed. The students were briefed on the importance of good manufacturing practices (GMP) and the role of regulatory bodies in ensuring drug safety and efficacy.

### **Tour of the Manufacturing Facility**

The highlight of the visit was the tour of the manufacturing facility. The students were taken to various sections of the plant, where they observed the bulk manufacturing process in detail. This included the weighing and dispensing area, granulation, blending, tablet compression, coating, and packaging departments.

  
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## **Weighing and Dispensing**

The tour began with the weighing and dispensing area, where raw materials are accurately measured and dispensed according to the formulation requirements. The students learned about the significance of precision in this initial step to ensure consistency and quality in the final product.

## **Granulation and Blending**

Next, the students observed the granulation process, where the raw materials are mixed with binding agents to form granules. They were shown both wet and dry granulation techniques and understood how the choice of method depends on the properties of the active pharmaceutical ingredient (API) and the desired characteristics of the final product. The granules are then blended to ensure uniform distribution of the API.

## **Tablet Compression**


The students then moved to the tablet compression section, where the blended granules are compressed into tablets using high-speed rotary presses. They observed the operation of the presses and the importance of parameters such as compression force and machine speed in producing tablets with the required hardness and disintegration time.

## **Coating and Packaging**

The tour concluded with a visit to the coating and packaging departments. The students saw how tablets are coated to improve their appearance, taste, and stability. The coating process involves spraying a solution onto the tablets while they are rotated in a coating pan. Finally, the students observed the packaging process, where the tablets are packed into blister packs or bottles, labeled, and prepared for distribution.

## **Interaction with Industry Experts**

Throughout the tour, the students had the opportunity to interact with industry experts and ask questions. The experts explained the challenges faced during the manufacturing process

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and the measures taken to overcome them. They also discussed the importance of maintaining hygiene and preventing contamination at every stage of production.

### **Conclusion**

The industrial visit to Maithili Life Sciences Private Limited was an enriching experience for the B.Pharm IV year students. It provided them with valuable insights into the practical aspects of pharmaceutical manufacturing and reinforced their understanding of the theoretical concepts learned in the classroom. The students left with a greater appreciation of the complexities involved in drug formulation and the critical role of quality control in ensuring the safety and efficacy of pharmaceutical products. Such visits are instrumental in preparing future pharmacists for their professional careers and fostering a deeper connection with the industry.

  
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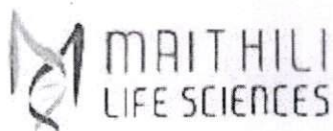

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## **PHARMACOKINETICS AND PHARMACODYNAMICS**

### **REAL-WORLD APPLICATIONS**

**RESOURCE PERSON : M.KRISHNAMURTHY**

**DATE : 19-08-2022**

On August 18, 2022, Narayana Pharmacy College hosted an insightful seminar titled "Pharmacokinetics and Pharmacodynamics: Real-World Applications," presented by M. Krishnamurthy. 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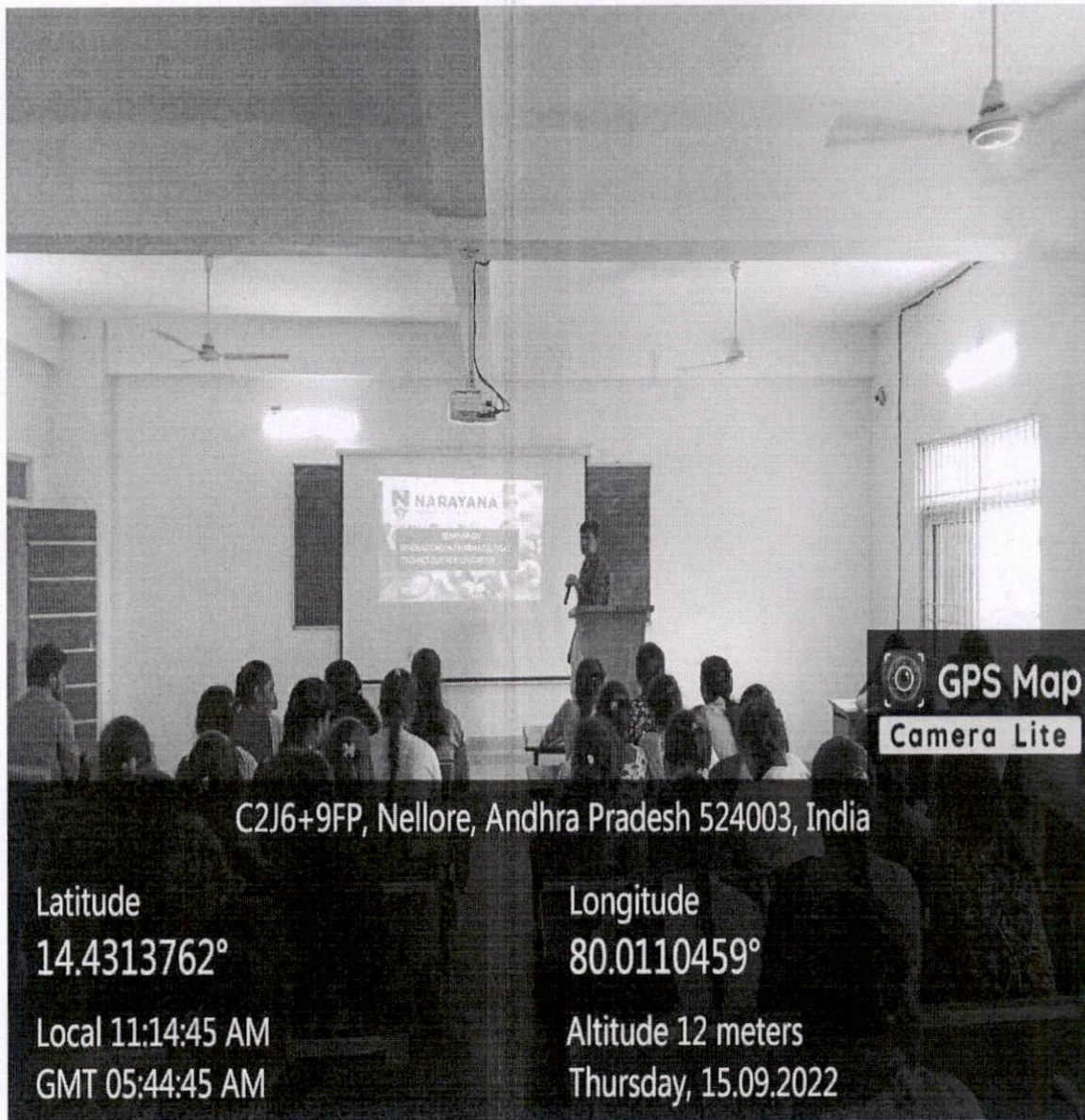

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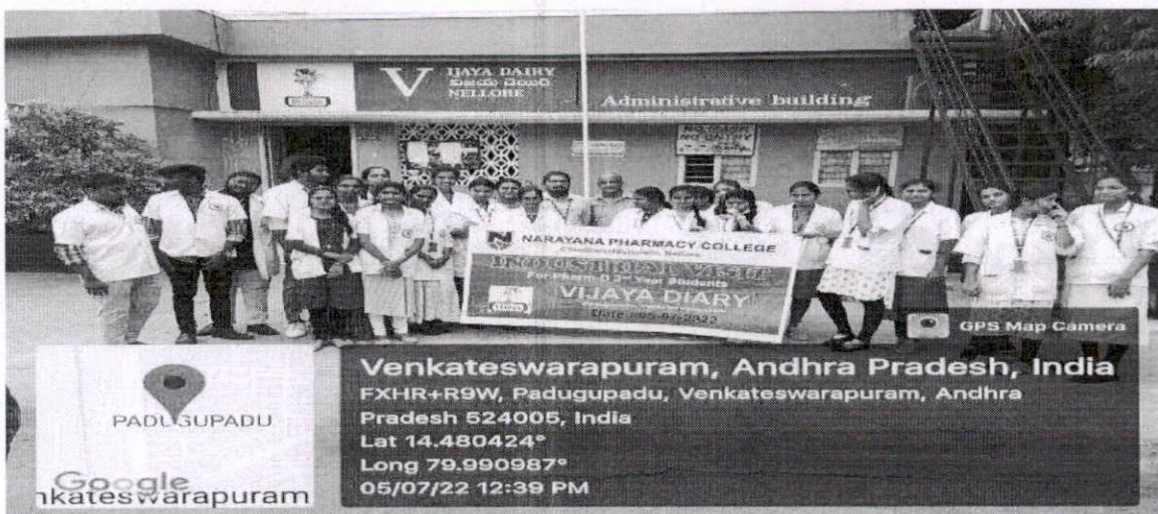

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## **Report on Visit to Vijaya Milk Dairy**

**Date:** 6th July 2022

**Visitors:** B.Pharmacy II Year Students

**Objective:** To observe and understand the pasteurization technique and temperature level controls in a dairy farm.

On the 6th of July, 2022, the second-year B.Pharmacy students embarked on an educational visit to the Vijaya Milk Dairy. The primary objective of this visit was to gain firsthand knowledge of the pasteurization process and the associated temperature controls that are crucial in dairy production. This visit was not only an opportunity to observe theoretical concepts in a practical setting but also to understand the importance of these processes in ensuring the safety and quality of milk products.


### **Introduction to Vijaya Milk Dairy**

Vijaya Milk Dairy is a well-known dairy farm that specializes in the production of various milk products. It is renowned for its stringent quality control measures and advanced processing techniques. The dairy follows meticulous procedures to ensure that the milk and milk products are safe for consumption and meet high-quality standards.

### **Pasteurization Process**

The students were introduced to the pasteurization process, which is a critical step in milk processing. Pasteurization involves heating the milk to a specific temperature for a set period to kill harmful bacteria without affecting the nutritional value and taste of the milk.

### **Key Steps in Pasteurization:**

  
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1. **Receiving and Testing Milk:** The raw milk is first received from the farms and tested for quality and contaminants. Only milk that passes these tests is allowed to proceed to the pasteurization process.
2. **Preheating:** The milk is preheated to a lower temperature before pasteurization to remove any air and to prepare it for the next step.
3. **Pasteurization:** The preheated milk is then heated to a temperature of at least 72°C (161°F) for 15 seconds in a high-temperature short time (HTST) pasteurizer. This temperature and time combination is effective in destroying harmful pathogens like Salmonella, E. coli, and Listeria.
4. **Cooling:** After pasteurization, the milk is rapidly cooled to a temperature of 4°C (39°F) to prevent the growth of any remaining microorganisms.
5. **Storage:** The pasteurized milk is then stored in sanitized tanks before being packaged for distribution.

## Temperature Level Controls

Temperature control is a critical aspect of the pasteurization process and overall milk processing. The students learned about the various stages where temperature control is essential:

- **Receiving and Storage:** The raw milk is stored at a low temperature to prevent spoilage and bacterial growth before it is processed.
- **Preheating:** Controlled preheating ensures that the milk reaches the required temperature for effective pasteurization without denaturing the proteins.
- **Pasteurization:** Precise control of the pasteurization temperature is crucial. The equipment used is calibrated regularly to maintain the correct temperature and time settings.
- **Cooling:** Rapid cooling is necessary to prevent the growth of thermophilic bacteria and to maintain the quality of the milk.
- **Storage and Distribution:** The final product is stored at 4°C or below and transported in refrigerated vehicles to ensure it remains safe for consumption.

  
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## **Observations and Learning Outcomes**

During the visit, the students observed the entire pasteurization process and the stringent temperature controls in place. They gained insights into the importance of maintaining hygiene and sanitation throughout the process. The students also understood the role of technology and automation in ensuring consistent quality and safety in dairy production.

## **Conclusion**

The visit to Vijaya Milk Dairy was an enlightening experience for the B.Pharmacy II Year students. It provided them with a comprehensive understanding of the pasteurization process and the critical role of temperature control in dairy processing. The knowledge gained from this visit will be invaluable in their future careers, especially for those interested in pharmaceutical applications related to food and nutrition.
