GOVERNMENT SCHOLARSHIP SCHEME

Narayana Pharmacy College, Nellore, provides financial assistance to students through the following government scholarship scheme:

1. Jagananna Vidya Deevena (JVD)

The **Jagananna Vidya Deevena** (**JVD**) is a flagship scholarship initiative launched by the Government of Andhra Pradesh to assist students from economically weaker sections. The scheme aims to remove financial barriers and ensure higher education for all eligible students.

Objectives:

- Offer full fee reimbursement to eligible students pursuing higher education.
- Empower students from low-income families to pursue their studies without financial strain.
- Improve the literacy rate and skill development among the youth, contributing to the state's socio-economic progress.

Implementation and Monitoring:

- Application Process: Eligible students must apply through the Andhra Pradesh State Scholarship Portal by submitting required documents like income certificates, caste certificates, and bank details.
- Verification: The submitted applications are verified by village/ward volunteers and relevant welfare officers.
- Disbursement: Scholarship funds are released in four phases throughout the academic year directly into the student's bank account.
- Grievance Redressal: A grievance redressal mechanism is available at the district and state levels for students facing delays or issues in the scholarship process.







Impact of the Scheme:

- Reduction in Dropout Rates: By providing full tuition reimbursement and
 maintenance support, the scheme has successfully lowered the dropout rates due to
 financial difficulties.
- Increased Enrollment: The scheme has significantly increased the enrollment of students from marginalized sections into higher education institutions, thereby promoting educational equity.

INSTITUTIONAL FREESHIP SCHEME

Narayana Pharmacy College, Nellore, offers financial assistance through its institutional freeship scheme for students who do not qualify for government scholarships. This policy is designed to ensure that deserving students, regardless of their economic background, have access to quality education

INSTITUTIONAL FREESHIP POLICY:

The institutional freeship policy provides financial relief to students based on **merit** and **economic status**. The main objective is to ensure that **talented and deserving students** receive the support they need to complete their education.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Merit-Based: Students with strong academic performance are eligible for freeship under the merit criteria.
- Economic Status-Based: Students from economically disadvantaged backgrounds are eligible for fee waivers based on their family's income.







Financial Assistance:

The freeships is provided in the form of fee concessions on tuition fees for all courses, including B.Pharm, Pharm D, and M.Pharm programs at Narayana Pharmacy College.

Categories of Freeship:

1. Meritorious Freeship:

Students who have secured more than 60% in their academics are eligible for a tuition fee waiver.

2. Economical Background-Based Freeship:

 Students with an annual family income of less than ₹2 lakhs are eligible for a tuition fee concession.
